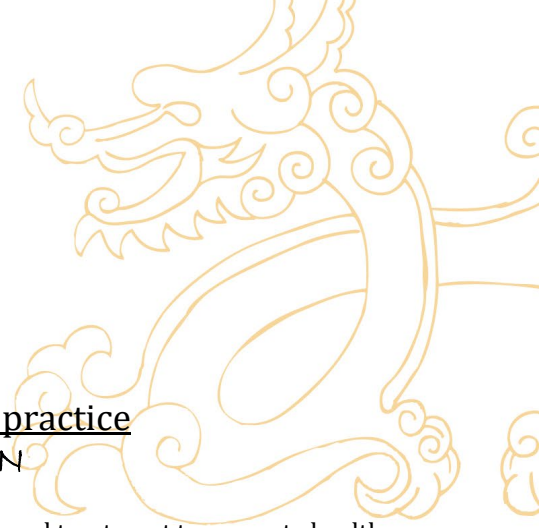

East Asian Medicine means a health care service using East Asian Medicine diagnosis and treatment to promote health and treat organic or functional disorders.

The scope of practice for East Asian Medicine practitioner in the state of Washington includes the following:

- Acupuncture, including the use of acupuncture needles or lancets to directly or indirectly stimulate acupuncture points and meridians
- Use of electrical, mechanical, or magnetic devices to stimulate acupuncture points and meridians
- Acupressure
- Moxibustion
- Cupping
- Dietary advice and health education based on East Asian Medical theory, including the recommendation and sale of herbs, vitamins, minerals, and dietary and nutritional supplements
- Breathing, relaxation and East Asian exercise techniques
- Qi Gong, Tai Chi
- Tui Na, which is a method of East Asian bodywork, characterized by the kneading, pressing, rolling, shaking, and stretching of the body and does not include spinal manipulation

Side effects may include:

- Pain following treatment
- Minor bruising
- Infection
- Needle sickness
- Broken needle

The patient must inform the East Asian Medicine practitioner if the patient has a severe bleeding disorder or pacemaker prior to any treatment
